CONSERVATION COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

THE CONSERVATION COMMISSION of the TOWN OF LYNNFIELD will hold a PUBLIC HEARING at **8:00 p.m.** on **Tuesday, June 20, 2017** in the **Selectmen's Hearing Room** at the Town Hall relative to a **NOTICE OF INTENT** filed by **Andrew Zuroff, c/o BOSTON CLEAR WATER COMPANY, LLC**, 450 Wildwood Avenue, Woburn to **CONSTRUCT A SEPTIC SYSTEM TO SERVICE AN EXISTING DRINKING WATER DISTRIBUTION BUILDING. THE PROJECT ALSO INCLUDES THE EXCAVATION REQUIRED TO LOCATE AND INSPECT AND REPLACE IF NECESSARY THE EXISTING WATER SUPPLY LINE FROM THE STONE SPRING BUILDING TO THE DISTRIBUTION BUILDING, PROVIDE WALKWAY TO THE SPRING BUILDING, CONSTRUCT A VEHICLE STORAGE AREA AND A SMALL ADDITION TO THE DISTRIBUTION BUILDING** at **165 Lowell Street**. The proposed work is within the buffer zone to a Bordering Vegetated Wetland. This notice is given in accordance with the Provisions of General Laws, Chapter 131, Section 40 as amended and Lynnfield's Environmental Bylaw. This notice is also posted on the Mass.
