CONSERVATION COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING

THE CONSERVATION COMMISSION of the TOWN OF LYNNFIELD will hold a PUBLIC HEARING at **6:45 p.m.** on **Tuesday, April 17, 2018** in the Selectmen's Hearing Room at Town Hall relative to a NOTICE OF INTENT, filed by **TOWN OF LYNNFIELD**, c/o Robert Dolan, Town Administrator, 55 Summer Street, Lynnfield. The project consists of the removal of an existing 54 inch culvert under the Rail bed embankment, south of Ford Avenue, to restore the Beaverdam Brook crossing to an open stream channel. The purpose of the project is restore natural stream flow and mitigate flooding issues associated with culvert blockages. The work is proposed in areas designated as Bank, Bordering Vegetated Wetland, Bordering Land Subject to Flooding, and Riverfront. This notice is given in accordance with the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 131, Section 40 as amended.
