ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for construction of the Orient Avenue Rain Gardens Project in the City of Melrose will be received at the office of the Public Works Department Engineering Division located in City Hall, 562 Main Street, Melrose, Massachusetts 02176 until 10:00 AM on Wednesday, April 25, 2018, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The Contract consists of furnishing and installing three rain gardens, one subsurface leaching system, two drop inlet/catch basin structures, four subdrainage returns to existing drain piping, and other appurtenant work at four locations on Orient Avenue.

Each Bid shall be submitted in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders and be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of five percent of the Total Bid Price.

The Successful Bidder must furnish a 100 percent Performance Bond and a 100 percent Payment Bond with a surety company acceptable to the City of Melrose.

Bidders may not withdraw their Bid for a period of sixty days, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays, after the actual date of the opening of the Bids.

The City of Melrose is an Equal Opportunity Employer. The City encourages MBE/WBE participation in response to the bid process.

Minimum Wage Rates as determined by the Deputy Director of the Department of Labor and Workforce Development under the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 149, Section 26 to 27H, as amended, apply to this Project. It is the responsibility of the Bidder, before the Bid opening, to request, if necessary, any additional information on Minimum Wage Rates for those trades people who may be employed for the proposed Work under this Contract.

Complete instructions for filing Bids are included in the Instructions to Bidders.

All Work required under this Contract shall be complete by June 22, 2018. Work performed beyond the periods set forth above will be subject to liquidated damages as specified in the Contract.

The bidding and award of this Contract will be under the provisions of M.G.L. Chapter 30, Section 39M.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informality in or to reject any or all Bids if deemed to be in its best interest.
