If you now are, or recently have been, in the <u>active</u> military service of the United States of America, then you may be entitled to the benefits of the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act. If you object to a foreclosure of the above-mentioned property <u>on that basis</u>, then you or your attorney must file a written appearance and answer in this court at **Three Pemberton Square**, **Boston, MA 02108** on or before **November 19, 2018** or you may be forever barred from claiming that you are entitled to the benefits of said Act.
