

## Notice of Hydrant Flushing

The Lynnfield Center Water District will conduct high velocity water main flushing of the distribution system during normal business hours <u>beginning April 30, 2019 and continuing through the month of May</u>. This is part of the ongoing regular maintenance of the water distribution system.

Residents may experience discolored water. low pressure or no pressure during this process. Discolored water

Residents may experience <u>discolored water</u>, <u>low pressure</u> or <u>no pressure</u> during this process. Discolored water should clear after running their cold water for a short period of time. Residents are also advised to <u>avoid doing</u> <u>laundry</u> during the flushing period and to <u>check their water</u> first by running cold water for a few minutes after each day's flushing period before starting their washing machine. If a customer experiences lower pressure at their fauce

<u>laundry</u> during the flushing period and to <u>check their water</u> first by running cold water for a few minutes after each day's flushing period before starting their washing machine. If a customer experiences lower pressure at their faucet after the flushing, they should check the faucet screen for particles which may have collected and clean it out if necessary.
