NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Pursuant to §126-3 of the Code of the Town of Wakefield, the Wakefield Historical Commission hereby gives notice that it will conduct a public hearing on Wednesday, October 23rd at 8:00 p.m. in the Heritage Room of the Americal Civic Center, 467 Main Street, Wakefield, Massachusetts, to consider the 9/11/19 application of James C Gettuso of JCG Investments LLC to the Building Inspector for permission to demolish the existing 'single family home' located on the property known and numbered as 13 Mansion Road, Wakefield, Massachusetts. The 2 1/2 story Colonial Revival house is also known as the Charles Winship house, built in 1903. The house appears on the National Register of Historic Places.

The purpose of the hearing will be to determine whether the demolition of the said buildings would be detrimental to the historical or architectural heritage or resources of the Town of Wakefield. All persons are welcome to attend and to offer their comments.
