

As consistent warmer weather approaches, along with gardening and outdoor activities, residents throughout the Lynnfield Center Water District (LCWD) are reminded that seasonal water use restrictions are in effect. These restrictions are ordered to maintain in compliance with water withdrawal permits and by the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection. Effective May 1, 2020, LCWD must conform with Level 2 Water Use Restrictions as outlined below. Violations of the restrictions are subject to a fine or fines.

Given the situation and with more families home on a consistent basis, water consumption throughout the District remains higher than usual. LCWD monitors this on a daily basis and will proceed to Level 3 restrictions when needed and when demand begins to approach supply capacity. Additional notification will be published and signs posted when additional restrictions are in effect.

Level 1	Normal Winter Conditions October 1 through May 1 No Water Use Restrictions
Level 2	Seasonal Water Use Restriction May 1 through September 30 Outdoor lawn and garden watering allowed Beginning 8 pm and Ending 6 am
Level 3	Outdoor lawn and garden watering allowed Two Days per week Tuesday and Saturday Beginning 8 pm and Ending 6 am
Level 4	Outdoor lawn and garden watering allowed By handheld hose and cans only No NON-ESSENTIAL Water Use
Level 5	Drought or Emergency Condition No Outdoor Water Use at Anytime
