In accordance with the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 40A, §5 and §200-30 of the Town of North Reading Zoning Bylaw, the North Reading Community Planning Commission will hold a virtual public hearing on April 6, 2021 at 8:15 p.m. The purpose of the public hearing is to provide interested parties with an opportunity to comment on a proposed amendment to the North Reading Zoning Bylaw and Zoning Map. The proposed amendment is as follows:

Amend the North Reading Zoning Map by changing the zoning designation of three (3) parcels of land located on Concord Street from the Residence A (RA) Zoning District to Industrial Office Zoning District. The parcels are specifically identified as follows:

14 Concord Street	(Map 18, Parcel 15)	14.10 Acres
12 Concord Street	(Map 18, Parcel 14)	40,047 (.92 Acres)
4 Concord Street	(Map 18, Parcel 13)	40,074 SF (.92 Acres)
